### Instructions

Write your name and class in the space provided overleaf.

You will study ten subjects in S3. All pupils are required to study English, Maths, French and Spanish which means you have to choose **six** other subjects. To ensure a broad general education, each pupil must choose **one** subject from the Social Studies column, **one** subject from the Science column, **one** subject from the Expressive Arts column and **one** subject from the Technologies column. You then have **two** remaining subjects to choose from the columns labelled Elective 1 and Elective 2.

Indicate **one** choice of subject from **each** column overleaf by circling, underlining or highlighting the subject name. Take care to ensure that you **do not choose the same subject more than once**. Please also note you are able to choose **either** Health and Food Tech **or** Practical Cookery but **not both**.

You must also obtain the signature of a member of staff for each choice of subject. This will normally be your class teacher from the department that teaches the subject. Please note that it is your responsibility to obtain each signature. Your option form will not be considered complete without an appropriate signature at the foot of each column.

Please note that it is not always possible to allocate a pupil all of their subject choices. For example, a subject may be withdrawn due to insufficient pupil numbers or staffing constraints. Ensure that you indicate a reserve subject in the space at the foot of this page.

(The remaining periods on your timetable are set aside for core subjects – Health & Wellbeing, RME & PE.)

Ensure that you bring this option form with you to the options interview. Where you have any difficulty completing the option form, you will be able to seek the advice of your PT Pupil Support or Depute Head. You can make a note in the 'Points for Discussion' box below.
