Project update

We are currently on **week 81** of the project. We are continuing with the cladding works around the exterior of the building and completing the final areas of brickwork. Internally we are continuing installing ceiling grids to allow the Mechanical & Electrical services to continue their final fix on the second and first floor.

Underfloor heating has now been installed on the Ground floor with the sports block commencing this week. Flooring works, joinery works, and fixed furniture install have also commenced on the second and first floor with a sample room being completed on the 2nd floor to allow the client an opportunity to see what a finished classroom will look like upon completion.

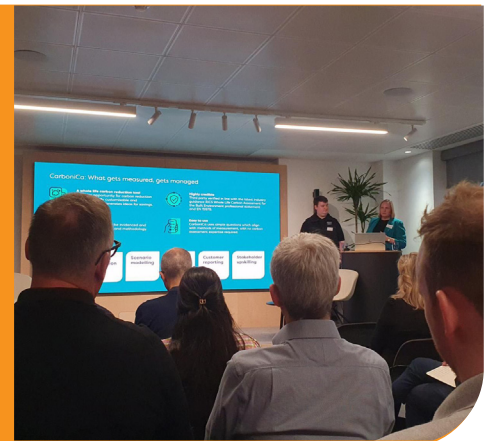
Macmillan Coffee Morning
